

The morphosintactic interference of portugues in the learning of spanish as a foreign language

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Between the Portuguese language and Spanish there is a great analogy, which provides a more precise vision of the academic status of the students and of the path to follow in the teaching of foreign languages, since each language evolves historically and acquires its own characteristics.
